What is a study and why is this study being done?

Research is what you do when you want to learn about something or find out something new.

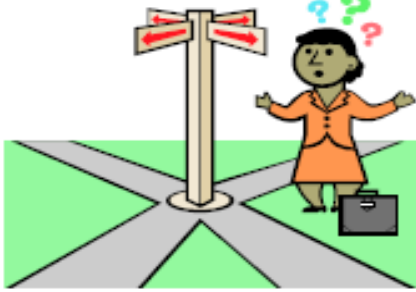
This research looks at different medicines which are called antibiotics. They are used to help treat people with Cystic Fibrosis (CF) whose lungs have become infected with a bacteria called Pseudomonas (pronounced sue-doe-moe-nas).

Why have I been asked to take part?

You are being asked to take part in this study because you have a lung infection caused by Pseudomonas.

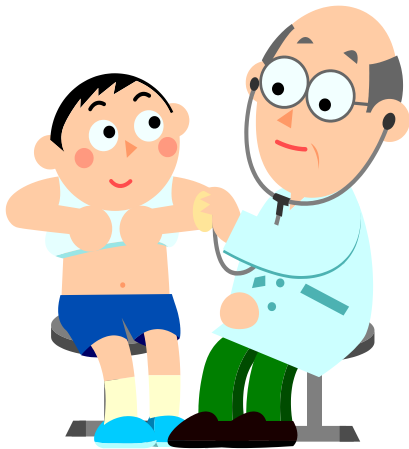


Children (5 years and under) Information and Assent Form

Do I have to take part?

No, it's completely up to you. Just say if you don't want to carry on. Nobody will mind.



What will happen to me during the study?

The study will last for 24 months, during that time you will visit the study doctor at the hospital 9 times. Before you start, your doctor will tell you and your parents what will happen to you.

Will taking the medicine upset me?

There are some side effects of the treatment, which may make you feel a little unwell. The study doctor will talk about this with your parents.

Who will look after me?

The doctors and nurses will look after you while you are being given medicine.



What will the doctors and nurse do?

The doctors and nurses will carry out some tests to check that you are ok

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What else happens in the study?

The doctors and nurses have written down notes about you for the study but only people at the hospital will know that these notes are about you.

Why is the study being done?

We hope that the study will help children with Cystic Fibrosis who have germs in their lungs.
